### **Risks to System**

- Payor mix.
- Patients using ER instead of PCP due to lack of access.
- Need to get to "problem" in community.
- Old EMS model equals \$\$\$
  - ✓ Not sustainable
- Workforce gaps
- Failing radio system county-wide.
- Hard to be nimble (EMCC and system).
- Changes happening faster than we can respond in large groups/bureaucracy.

### What does the EMCC want to achieve?

- Evaluating the system.
- Identify weaknesses in the system.
- Improvements to the system.
- Prepare for future (payer mix issues).
- Adapting to changing conditions.
- How to better serve the community.
- Make sure emergency services continue
  - ✓ Care for providers and patients.
- Advocate and promote.
- Overseer role.
- Being a guide
- Monitor.
- Help direct.
- Figure out future needs.
- Bring information from those they represent (area for improvement).
- Take back information to who they represent (area for improvement).
- Understand payer issues to recommend steps to mitigate (using subject matter expertise).
- Public engagement/input on system.
